## **Ave Maria Grotto**

Named to the National Register of Historic Places, the Ave Maria Grotto was built by Brother Joseph Zoettl over a period of 40 years on the grounds of Alabama's first and only Benedictine Abbey. The 3-acre site consists of more than 125 miniature reproductions of famous churches, shrines and buildings.

## **Shrine of the Most Blessed Sacrament of our Lady of the Angels Monastery**

Built by Mother Angelica and located in the City of Hanceville, it is the home of the Poor Clare nuns of the Perpetual Adoration. It is modeled after European 13th century monasteries with both Spanish and Italian influences. The monastery features stained glass windows from Germany, building stone from Canada, marble pillars and inlaid marble designs from Italy, roofing tiles from Columbia, South America, carved stonework decorations from artisans in Spain, and the main

altar area is made of carved cedar covered in gold leaf. The Monastery Chapel and grounds are open to the public from 6 AM until 6 PM, Masses are held daily at 7 AM with confessions heard directly following the mass.

## **Clarkson Covered Bridge**

One of Alabama's largest covered truss bridges and the site of the 1863 Battle of Hog Mountain. Named to the National Register of Historic Places, the bridge is the centerpiece of a public park spanning a shallow creek surrounded by hiking trails and picnic grounds. Open daily

### **Cullman County Museum**

This replica of the home of city founder Col. Johann G. Cullmann houses thousands of historical items dating back to the early 1800's. Displays include an Archaeological Room with Indian artifacts, a Primitive Room showing turn-of-the-century tools, a Clothing Store with outfits from the 1800's, a Main Street exhibit with 19th century storefronts, and a photo gallery. ### **Evelyn Burrow Museum of Wallace State College**

The collection began 64 years ago and includes thousands of rare and unique items, some from the Smithsonian Institute. On display are 97 rare pieces of Dresden porcelain, fine antique glassware, antique furniture and a host of other collectibles. The owners honor their World Champion horse, a Tennessee Walker named Ebony's Leading Lady, with one of the world's largest horse statue collections. The \$9.5 million collection was donated to Wallace State Community College in 2004.

### **Crooked Creek Civil War Museum**

Nestled in the rolling hills, surrounded by sounds of the steady stream is the site of the Crooked Creek Civil War Battle along the Forrest/Streight trail and the museum, housed in an old log cabin, features displays of numerous authentic Civil War memorabilia. ## **Echota Cherokee Interpretive Center**

The Echota Cherokee Interpretive Trails have approximately 1.5 miles of naturalized trails with a wide variety of native plants and trees. Many of the plants are labeled for identification. Middle, Lower and Over the Hill Trail. These trails were named because of the different towns of the Cherokee Nation: the Middle Towns, Lower Towns and Over the Hill Towns. An 1860's log house shows the architecture and the life of early Americanized Cherokees. Features an Outdoor Classroom that will seat

approximately 30 children. Outdoor educational programs include: environmental responsibility, ecology, biology, history and cultural information.

# Educational Excursions

Here are some additional educational itineraries that may fit your group

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## EDUCATIONAL EXCURSION

Begin your experience at World Famous **Ave Maria Grotto** also known as “Little Jerusalem” where you can explore the creations of Brother Joseph Zoettl – kids enjoy a scavenger hunt through this park as you look for various items incorporated in these amazing folk art creations and learn about the process of making these spectacular creations. Next, take a journey to **Cullman County Museum** and learning about early Native American settlers through a timeline of Native American artifacts, demonstrations of arrowhead making, use of a throwing stick, and examples of Native American pottery with a rare, full pot – create an Indianhead rubbing to remember your experience, explore the underwater life of Smith Lake several woodland scenes depict the mammals, birds and reptiles that can be found locally in the wild. Next enjoy a sack lunch under the **Historic Clarkson Covered Bridge** at the picnic tables. Discover the days of old when horse-drawn carriages traveled across this beautiful historic bridge. Enjoy a stroll along the beautiful walking trails and take photos of the Grist Mill. Travel to the **Evelyn Burrow Museum of Wallace State College** and view the \$9.5 million collection. Learn about the different types of art included in this amazing museum and hear the stories behind their collection. Venture to **Seven Winds Candy Kitchen** and see a candy making demonstration and tasting – YUMMY! End the day at the **Echota Cherokee Interpretive Center** and tour the Cherokee Dog Trot Log Cabin, hike the trails to see the Native American Bluff Shelters, see and learn about the many medicine plants used by the Cherokee Indian Tribes.

## 3<sup>RD</sup> GRADE FARM LIFE EDUCATIONAL EXCURSION

Spend the Day at Peinhardt Living History Farm - Peinhardt Edgewood Farm is primarily an evolving family farm focusing on rural life in the 1930's and 1940's. The goal of this program is to help fill this void in children's experience that is creating an agricultural illiteracy. The program theme is "Life and Living on a Working Family Farm." The focus is that the barnyard and animals, the house and garden, the field, the woods and the horses all have an important purpose in helping the farmer make a living for him and his family. Stations set-up around farm with interactive activities. **House Station & Garden:** churning milk for butter, wood stove for cooking, preserving foods, washing clothes with wash pot, making apple butter or sassafras tea or wild greens and garden activities. **Barn & Barnyard Station:** milking a cow, shelling corn, viewing hay, petting barnyard animals, gathering eggs and feeding baby calves. **Woods Station:** tree identification, learn importance of wood resources, show animal resources and trapping demonstration, using dated tools such as cross-cut saws, wedge and froe, etc. — students will actually split rails and stack them to construct a fence. **Work Animals Station:** learn about horses, mules, and oxen; feel the difference between surrey rides and working wagon rides, and sit in saddles on mounted board frame. **Field Station:** ride on hay wagon, pick crops, such as corn, cotton and pumpkins; digging sweet potatoes in fall; watch plowing with a mule; and participate in planting or harvesting crops depending on season.
